Your recent correspondence addressed to the command staff of this department has been forwarded to me for review and response.

Our officers have been advised that they are required to accept a firearms permit application without the requirement of letters of reference. We will continue to require proof of bona fide residence in the City of Waterbury upon submission of the application.

However, In accordance with Judge Dyer's ruling in the matter of Town of Farmington v. Board of Firearms Permit Examiners once the application has been submitted this department will continue to request references and confer with persons that know the defendant. This action will be taken pursuant to our obligation to conduct an investigation to determine the applicant's suitability to receive a permit.
