Dear Chief of Police Edward Stephens,

I have received information that your department has given false information with regards to pistol permit applications and training certification evidence for the same. I have been told that Wolcott PD will not accept NRA training certificates that are older than one year.

Please be advised that this is not the law, and that the certificates never expire. In fact, applicants are recommended to submit only copies of the certificate and keep the original for life.

Your department may not reject a permit application for an 'expired' training certificate. This has been clearly established by the Board of Firearms Permit Examiners. We will assist any citizen in Wolcott in appealing any rejection of a pistol permit for this reason in an expedited manner and we will seek compensation from the Town of Wolcott to reimburse any monies that we spend in this pursuit.
